Firearm Detection on Common Security Cameras

RAD'S ROSS ENHANCES SCHOOL SECURITY MEASURES

AITX's subsidiary RAD has successfully deployed its ROSS solution at The Rosenbaum Yeshiva of North Jersey, enabling legacy IP security cameras to connect with the RAD ecosystem and use AI analytics for threat detection.

The school, with nearly 1000 students, conducted accuracy testing with RAD for months. Four RAD ROSA units will be deployed, offering autonomous responses upon detecting pre-determined activities.

The cost-effective solution aims to increase safety in schools, houses of worship, and other vulnerable facilities. Troy McCanna, RAD's Chief Security Officer, emphasized the importance of ROSS in potentially saving lives in active shooter situations.

Concerns include biased AI responses, misinformation spread, consumer privacy, and job displacement.
